NOTIFICATION OF WORKS Gerrards Cross Tesco Store

Goliath Crane Installation Works commencing on Thursday 4th June 2009

Dear Resident or Property Owner,

As part of the works for the development of the Tesco Store in Gerrards Cross, work will shortly commence to install two Goliath Cranes, to facilitate Costain in the building of a permanent reinforced concrete arch structure.

Network Rail has mandated that the installation of these Goliath Cranes will take place exclusively at night when the railway is closed to all traffic. The times available for this rail possession work are Sunday from 0035 to 0730 hours, and Monday to Saturday from 0035 to 0530 hours.

This work is due to commence on Thursday 4th June 2009, and is anticipated to take two weeks to complete. The Goliath Cranes - comprising several large fabricated components manufactured off-site - will be delivered to Gerrards Cross under abnormal load escort on special types of oversize trailers, in an out-of-hours operation. They will be erected on-site with the use of the existing Crawler Crane located on the development.

At times during this period it is possible that you may hear this plant working; we would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience that this may cause. Measures will be implemented to reduce this sound to the lowest practicable level.

Please see overleaf for a drawing of an installed Goliath Crane and its location to the existing precast tunnel units, and the forthcoming reinforced concrete arch structure.

Throughout the summer, other works at the West Portal of the tunnel - adjacent to Packhorse Road Bridge - will continue to be undertaken at night.
