## **NOTIFICATION OF WORKS Gerrards Cross Tesco Store**

### **Block 5 Reinforced Concrete Arch Structure Works commencing on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2009**

Dear Resident or Property Owner,

As part of the works for the development of the Tesco Store in Gerrards Cross, work will shortly commence to build a Reinforced Concrete Arch Structure on 'Block 5', a 35m long section of the tunnel directly adjacent to Packhorse Road Bridge.

This work is due to commence in the evening of Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2009, and is anticipated to take approximately ten weeks to complete, with a likely finish in mid November 2009.

To facilitate Costain in the construction of this Reinforced Concrete Arch, temporary access platforms and formwork will be erected, and reinforcement steel lifted into place, with the use of two Crawler Cranes located on site.

Network Rail has instructed that the use of these Crawler Cranes take place exclusively at night when the railway is closed to all traffic. The times available for this rail possession work are Sunday from 0035 to 0730 hours, and Monday to Saturday from 0035 to 0530 hours.

Although we expect these night-time lifting operations to cause very little disturbance, during this period it is possible that you may hear this plant working; we would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience that this may bring about. Measures will be implemented to reduce this sound to the lowest practicable level.

With the formwork in place and reinforcement steel assembled, the Reinforced Concrete Arch will be constructed in segments of poured concrete, in a specific sequence. This work will take place during normal daytime working hours only.
