NOTIFICATION OF WORKS Gerrards Cross Tesco Store

Temporary Access Bridge Removal Works commencing on Thursday 14th January 2010

Dear Resident or Property Owner,

As part of the works for the development of the Tesco Store in Gerrards Cross, work will shortly commence to decommission and remove the on-site Temporary Access Bridge, which has spanned the tunnel structure since its installation in April 2008.

This operation is due to commence in the evening of Thursday 14th January 2010, and is anticipated to take four successive nights to accomplish with a completion by no later than 0800 hours on Monday 18th January 2010.

To facilitate Costain in the removal of the Temporary Access Bridge, a 500 tonne capacity mobile crane will be employed. This will be transported on-site and assembled on Saturday 16th January 2010. Network Rail has instructed that the use of this mobile crane will take place exclusively at night when the railway is closed to all traffic.

The Temporary Access Bridge will be lifted out in component sections and removed off-site over the two nights of Saturday 16th / Sunday 17th January 2010 and Sunday 17th / Monday 18th January 2010, between 2000 hours and 0800 hours. The mobile crane will subsequently be disassembled and also transported off-site by 0800 hours on Monday 18th January 2010.

Although we expect this night-time lifting operation to cause very little disturbance, during this period it is possible that you may hear the mobile crane working; we would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience that this may bring about.
