NOTIFICATION OF WORKS Gerrards Cross Tesco Store

**Goliath Crane Demobilisation Works commencing on
Friday 16th April 2010**

Dear Resident or Property Owner,

As part of the works for the development of the Tesco Store in Gerrards Cross, work will soon commence to demobilise and remove the two large Goliath Cranes currently operating astride the tunnel structure east of Packhorse Road bridge.

Network Rail has instructed that the removal of these cranes will take place exclusively at night when the railway is closed to all traffic. The first of these Goliath Cranes will be removed over four successive nights commencing in the evening of Friday 16th April 2010, and the second will be similarly removed over four successive nights commencing in the evening of Friday 23rd April 2010.

To facilitate Costain in the removal of the two Goliath Cranes, a pair of smaller mobile cranes of 60 tonne and 130 tonne capacity will be employed. Each Goliath Crane will be disassembled into several large components and subsequently transported off-site on special types of oversize trailers under abnormal load escort.

Although we expect this operation to cause very little disturbance, during this period it is possible that you may hear the mobile cranes or other vehicles working; we would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience that this may cause.
